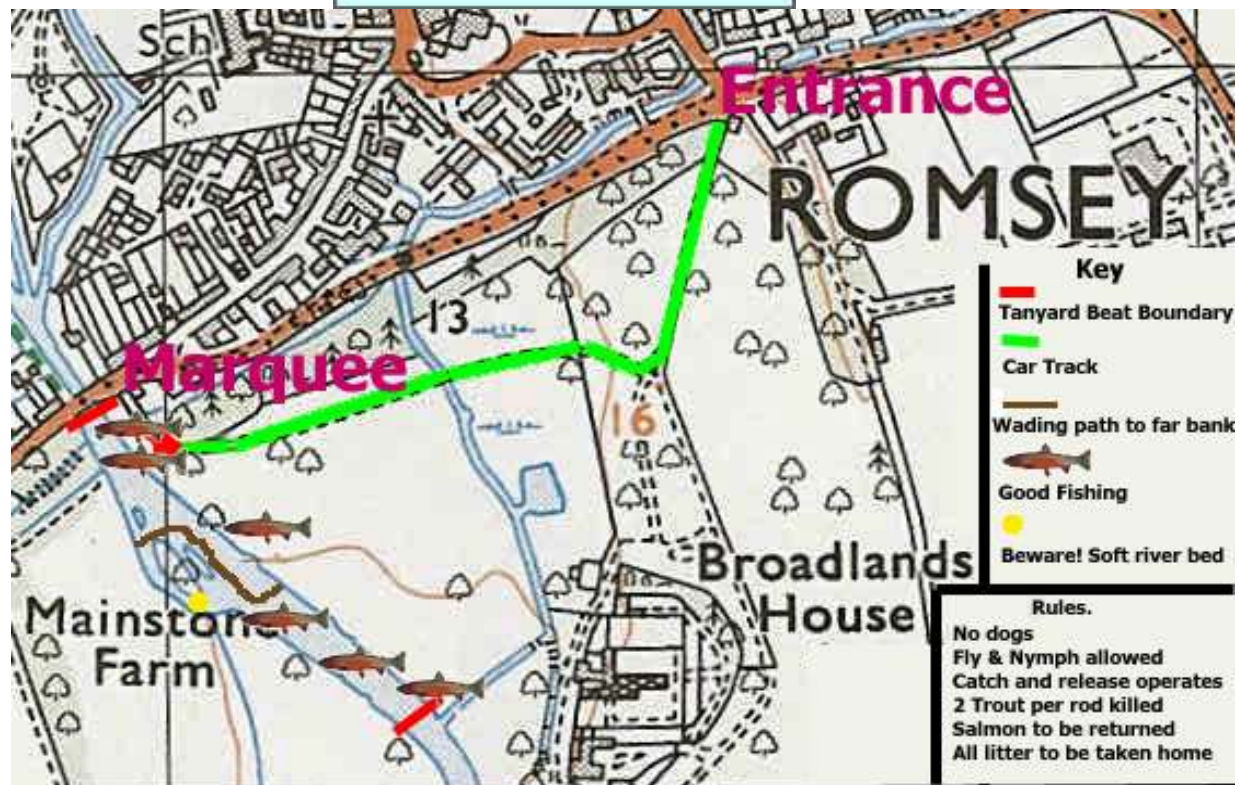


How to get to the Tanyard Beat, BROADLANDS, Romsey, Hampshire, SO51 9ZD

The Tanyard Beat is situated in Broadlands. Broadlands is on the A3090 Romsey by-pass, ½ mile from Romsey town centre. The M27 motorway runs 3 miles from Broadlands providing excellent motorway and trunk road links in all directions - Central London is only 2 hours from Broadlands via the M3 and M27 motorways. Drivers should leave the M27 motorway at Junction 3 if approaching from the North and East, or Junction 2 if approaching from the West, and follow the signs to Broadlands.



The beat is accessed through the main gate off the main road roundabout. Please swipe the electronic fob in front of the concealed eye (rear of left pillar on pedestrian access gate, shoulder height).
WAIT FOR GATE TO CLOSE BEFORE MOVING OFF.

Proceed along main drive for 200 yds and you will see a No Entry sign on the right. Follow this track to 5 bar gate which is permanently locked. The code will be advised. Close gate and lock after entry.

The beat is from the road bridge upstream to the carrier / fence down stream (1/3 rd of a mile approx double bank).

Chaser waders are required to access far bank and to fish in the river. Use the wading path shown on the map.
DO NOT cross by the tent or other places! This is for your safety.
